MULTI-FUNCTIONAL CULTURAL CENTRES IN MONTENEGRO, ITALY AND ALBANIA

The multi-functional culture centers will be mainly used for the Regional Arts Mobility and Visiting program. Thanks to 3C Project the renovated spaces could be used for educational workshops, presentations, manifestations.

The three buildings/territory involved in the renovations are:

- ✚ [Old prison in Kotor](#), Montenegro. Reconstruction of the old prison building in the Old town of Kotor. The building will be mainly used for the Regional Arts visiting program. The space could be used for educational workshops, presentations, manifestations, but also as a space for the temporary accommodation of guest and artists. All mentioned premises Its contains the following:
 - a conference (workshops) rooms, up to 25 people with the necessary video and audio equipment;
 - rooms for student work, up to 20 people;
 - rooms for individual work of students or courses' and workshops' participants;
- ✚ The territory of *Kinostudio Shqipëria e Re* in Albania, the realization of [Park of Art](#). The purpose of this project is to promote the cultural heritage values of this area and increase the number of visitors to the park who generate revenue for the park. The specific purpose of the project is to educate young people and other members of the community through culture.;
- ✚ [Palazzo Ex Gil](#) in Molise, safety with building works maintenance extraordinary outdoor area entrance exhibition hall and garage entrance area via Gorizia in the basement of the building former GIL; replacement of a lift to overcome architectural barriers, from floor basement on the 1st floor.
- ✚ Puglia Region invested in the multi-functional culture center localized in the Regional Library-Museum Pole of Bari, a diffused system that includes a restored building in the former "Caserma Rossani" area, a former military barracks in the central part of Bari, and the "[Kursaal Santa Lucia](#)" theatre. In particular, in the Kursaal Santalucia , the interior fitting out of the House of the Arts (in particular the Giuseppina Room and the offices), including some artworks, has been completed, while in the former Rossani Barracks it has been installed the artwork by maestro Pirri "Compagni e Angeli", an artwork dedicated to the memory of Antonio Granmsci, that will welcome visitors to the new Public Library in the former Rossani Barracks, which, once the fitting-out work is completed, will be a reference library centre at regional level, the physical headquarters of Apulia's library services system.
